Another more roundabout way is to take all those hundreds of blueberries you have steaming out of your ears from your summer harvest and run them all through a Seed Maker. Just follow these tips and you'll be on the right track to explore even stuff for yourself! You, are funny and informative. So far I have the green house(sold my soul to joja and paid \$30k for it), am working on Shane (5 hearts atm) have some chickens, just expanded my house for a kitchen and am on the lookout for battery packs at the travelling van. For friendship, put some chests with loved gifts close to where you meet NPCs regularly (e.g. in the mountains for Linus and Robins family, one near Emily's and Jodi's houses for their families, etc. But, no matter how much time you spend playing Stardew Valley, there are some things that you still may never learn. Bombs are your friends in the mines lse your upgraded tools. There's many ways to gain this seed. So instead of roughly 600k per season, you're going to be making a literal million plus per season. My current advice is "except for birthdays and meeting any remaining people at the Egg Festival, leave socializing until after the Luau." It's so easy to befriend people once you can cook and get diamonds and rabbits' feet. For every tree you chop down plant a tree. This is the first week you can start brewing, and everything will be fully grown within three weeks. C. That's 31 picks, 31 Fruit into Preserves Jars, and 31 removed from Preserves Jars. stuffs: 999 wood for ~10K is nice, but only available in Year 1. Farming insects in the upper levels (11-29) can net you one. Well, the more materials you start saving up, the sooner you can purchase a coop, and with it, animals. If you do big wood projects enjoy your forests, don't cut them down. Don't forget your trashcan can be upgraded like your other tools. There may be specific resources you want specific quantities of (such as 50 wood to make a chest to store things in so you aren't limited to your inventory), but on the whole, just randomly gathering resources is going to burn out all your energy and leave you with more critical tasks left unfulfilled. If you're like many players and keep them inside a shed or barn, you'll know how frustrating it can be to walk inside to check if they're ready yet, only to find out that they're not and you wasted time. Other quick things is quality bait makers (you really only need a few if you don't fish incredibly often), the trap bobber, and to check the wiki for fishing. starts with a single seed. And before the end of Spring, you've already got your million per month passive income going in full swing. But that more expensive stack of 999 wood only costs 31 Ancient Fruit Jelly. Once you are wealthy enough or achieve everything, the experience of playing this game comes to end. Week 6, you now have 3 fruit from this week's harvest, the original and the first two planted. Tree fertilizer is a gift, like on a level with Prometheus bringing us fire kind of gift. Your two main resources you will struggle with on your first day are time and energy. But, if you want to get a rare and majestic Giant Crop, make sure that you don't pick them right away. Leave a Keg outside of the barn or shed. Beware of gift tastes, though-most villagers will drop hints about what they like and don't like, so pay close attention! Why is befriendng people so important, you ask? Did I mention materials? Both are equally fine. You should try to max friendship with everyone before making every recipe because many are obtained from heart events. I also recommend buying shed(s) to maximize on space on your farm. Because you'll never experience it that way again. As luck would have it, we're here to share a few with you today. If you do go over 15, may as well go big (40) on Parsnips only, I guess. In the Cindersap (both near Marnie's and across the river where you can get spring onions), in the Mountains by Robin's, and up by the Spa there is plenty of tillable space for planting trees that you can chop later too. Side note: I'm not an expert, and if you know everything on this list, good for you! When bored with the game try modding - it's super easy to do and makes the game have more life. If the rock you're looking at doesn't have a shadow, don't bother hitting it because it's a crab. 60 trees x 12 chops (avg). This is late summer Year 2. This shortens substantially if you have multiple seeds to start off with. you still usually have to water on the first of the season. Get a shed with a lot of chests if you need to. "Buy seeds" is a great part of Y1 Spring I advice if you specify to (possibly) buy just 1 Green Bean Starter and 1 Cauliflower to plant with 13 Parsnips.
