How to reset BIOS admin password on Dell laptop? A lot of people are confused about this question. Dont worry. This post of MiniTool summarizes 4 accessible ways for the Dell laptop BIOS password reset. BIOS stands for basic input/output system and it is a firmware embedded on the chip on the computers motherboard. When your computer boots, BIOS is the first software to run and is responsible for waking up the computers hardware components, making sure they are up and working properly. It works as a communication interface between your computers hardware and operating system. If you forgot the BIOS password accidentally, then you may fail to start up the system. In this case, you may need to clear or reset Dell BIOS password. So, what types of passwords can be set up in BIOS of a Dell computer? Here are 3 main types of Dell BIOS passwords. System or User Password: You must enter it to log in to the computer. This type of password prevents an unauthorized user from using the computer. You cannot enter BIOS, access the boot menu, or boot into your operating system without the password. Setup or Admin password: When you access and make changes to the BIOS settings of the Dell laptop, you must enter the password. It can prevent an unauthorized user from accessing and making changes to the BIOS settings. HDD password: When you enter BIOS to access the hard drive and continue to boot into the OS, you must enter the password. It can prevent an unauthorized user from accessing your hard drive and booting into your system. Sometimes, however, many users forgot BIOS password of their Dell laptops. How to reset the BIOS admin password on Dell laptop? Lets keep reading. After investigating many posts and references, we summarized the following 4 simple ways for resetting Dell default BIOS password. You can try them in order or choose one that works best for you. Way 1. Reset Dell BIOS Password Via the Service Manuals The first and simplest method for the Dell default BIOS password is to directly use the Dell Service Manuals. Heres how to do that: Step 1. Click here to open the Dell Manuals website. Step 2. Enter the Service Tag, Express Service Code, or the Serial number of your Dell computer in the box and click on Search. If you dont know where to find the Dell Service Tag/Serial Number, this post provides a guide for you. Or, you can also click on Browse all products and select your Dell product from the results. Step 3. Scroll down to the Manuals and Documents section, and then click on View PDF or View Page next to the Service Manual of your Dell product. Step 4. Go to the BIOS setup program section and click on Clearing Forgotten Passwords. Then follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Dell BIOS password resetting. Note: The procedure may vary between different Dell laptops. Here we take Dell Inspiron 3252 for example. Way 2. Reset Dell BIOS Password Via the PSWD Jumper If you forgot BIOS password accidentally, resetting the CMOS or NVRAM can help you reset Dell default BIOS password. To do so, follow the steps below carefully. Note: Clearing the CMOS or NVRAM will use the PSWD jumper resets in BIOS, which includes the Dell BIOS user password, admin password, and HDD password. Well, it doesnt include any other passwords such as online accounts, Windows logon, and so on. Step 1. Before you start the following steps, make sure to read the Safety Precautions when working with electronic and electrical equipment. Step 2. Turn off your computer and disconnect it from the power source. Step 3. Navigate to the PSWD or CMOS jumper section according to your system board. Step 4. Remove the jumper plug from the password jumper pins carefully. Step 5. Power on your computer without the jumper plug to clear the Dell default BIOS password. Step 6. Wait until your laptop is loaded, and then shut down your computer and replace the jumper plug into its original location. Way 3. Reset Dell BIOS Password via a Pass Code Some users reported that they perform the Dell BIOS password reset successfully by using a pass code. Here you may have a try. Step 1. Power on your computer and press F2 or F12 to enter BIOS settings. Step 2. In the BIOS settings, press the Unlock button and note down the System Number. Step 3. Now, open another computer and click here to open the Clear unknown BIOS passwords website. Step 4. Type the System Number you just wrote down into the Enter your code box and click on Get password. Then you should get the following codes: Dell HDD Serial Number (use this code to reset your HDD password) Dell from serial number (use this code to reset the Dell Admin password) Step 5. Go back to the Dell Setup Unlock screen, type the password you just got from the biospw.org website, and press Ctrl + Enter to clear the admin password. If luckily, you can get the Dell BIOS password bypassed and make changes to BIOS settings. Way 4. Reset Dell BIOS Password by Contacting the Technical Support As you might know, BIOS passwords cannot be restored. So, we recommend you contact Dell Technical Support to get a password release code. Press the F9 key to setup default settings. Also, you can use the combination of Alt + F to force the settings to its default or click the Load default button on the screen to load the default settings. Step 3: After default the settings press the Esc button from your Dell laptop keyboard to close the Bios. It will ask you to save the changes before closing or close without save the settings. The other option for Save and Exit is also available, just press the F10 key on your keyboard and press the enter. Step 4: Now your Dell laptop will be restarting. After restarting, the Bios settings set on its default factory settings. Option 2. Reset/Remove Bios Admin Password on Dell Laptop Using CMD The second option for Dell laptop Bios password reset is Using CMD. To use this method, firstly you should launch the DOS mode on your Dell laptop. For launching the DOS mode on your laptop, you need a bootable media that you plug in to boot in DOS mode. When you open the DOS mode enter the following commands and execute them: -o 70 10-o 71 ff-q Now restart your Dell laptop and the issue is solved. Option 3. Reset/Remove Bios Admin Password on Dell Laptop by Removing the CMOS Battery You can reset/remove the Bios Admin password on Dell laptop by detaching and readjust the CMOS coin cell battery. This method is used when you are unable to approach the jumpers on your Dell laptop. Step 1: Turn-off the Dell laptop. Detach its battery and remove its back cover. Step 2: Locate the coin cell battery and detach its cable or remove the cell. Step 3: Now press the power button at least 10 seconds to drain all residing power from the laptop. Step 4: After that insert the coin cell battery again to its location. Step 5: Now set the laptop cover and power it on. Step 6: After starting the Dell laptop, it will tell you that time and date are not set, which shows that the dell laptop password reset is successfully done. Option 4. Contact Dell Support Bonus If you can not able to use the above methods or these methods did not work for you then try to contact Dell Support to help you. Almost all Dell laptops have a default master password. It will clear the Bios password. Contact the technical support of Dell for how to remove Bios password in Dell laptop, they will ask you for some information about your Dell laptop. That includes the Express Service Code and Service Tag. You can locate this information on the back of your Dell laptop. After confirmation, they will give you a master password that helps you to erase the Bios password from your Dell Laptop. Tip: How to Reset Dell Laptop Login Password using Windows Password Reset Windows Password Reset is a very efficient Windows password reset tool. That covers all the passwords like user password, Microsoft account password and domain password for all Windows versions 10/8.1/8/7/vista/xp/2016/2012/2008/2003 and 2000. After resetting, you can also generate a new Administration password through this software. It has five different additions, choose the appropriate addition according to your Windows password. It has very simple steps of how to break Bios password in Dell laptop and set it blank. Step 1: Download Windows Password Reset and install it on PC. For resetting the password it works on a bootable disk that you make on a CD/DVD or USB. Free Download Buy Now (Pro) Step 2: Both options are on the main window and can choose the first option for CD/DVD to create a password reset disk. And for the USB, choose the USB from the directory. Im stuck with black screen after booting. The keyboard lights and the front LED are on, nothing else. Powering on the laptop with pressing D starts the display test and it works so it is not a display issue. Let me explain how i got here. I have been using the laptop with ubuntu 19.10 booting in legacy mode. After the newest update and a reboot i got only in minimal grub. I was trying to repair grub and switched from legacy to UEFI which got me to a black screen, keyboard lights on and a 4 beeps signal that kept on repeating. Next i unplugged all peripherals and AC, opened the laptop removed the CMOS battery and the battery. Pressed the power button for 30sec, put everything back in order and tried to boot it. This time still black screen, keyboard lights on, but no beeping this time. Next i tried to flash the BIOS, following the solution here: ... I can see that the laptop boots and starts to read the flash drive but then nothing happens and the white LED keeps on blinking still black screen. Tied many many times to flash from the usb drive and waited for hours but nothing happens. The led on the usb flashes in the beginning while keyboard lights are on as well as the front indicator led. Then the light of the usb goes off and the indicator led on the front of the laptop flashes. Is there another way to reset the NVRAM?? Any other ideas i could try? Apart from this the laptop has been stellar and would love to keep it. Thanks. Hi all, I got an Dell XPS 13 9370 with admin password set. Manually change the suffix to 1F5A or BF97 and try the password you get from that. e.g. D51WYM2-1F5A = 1y2DtA27gQQwyuFA or D51WYM2-BF97 = 8WQmZXk5L1L239 Hold left Ctrl and press Enter when you've typed the password.
