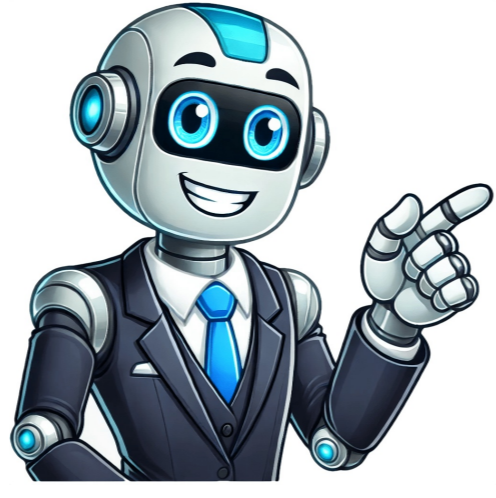

Pirates Cove Watersports out of Key Largo Take a sunset cruise that's relaxing, scenic, and toddler-friendly. The shallow waters make for a smooth ride, and you have great chances of dolphin sightings—plus the golden light at sunset was incredible. The Turtle Hospital, Marathon For something heartwarming and educational, this nonprofit hospital rehabilitates injured sea turtles and releases them back into the wild. Guided tours give you a behind-the-scenes look at marine animal care—perfect for anyone who loves animal welfare or eco-conscious travel. Playa Largo Resort & Spa in Key Largo You don't have to "rough it" to be a real traveler. If you're the kind of solo explorer who recharges through comfort and beauty, these spots are ideal. Playa Largo has beachfront access, a serene pool, and on-site dining—so you can soak in the surroundings without needing to leave the property. Hawks Cay Resort in Duck Key (near Marathon) Hawks Cay Resort is located on Duck Key with that perfectly aquamarine water you think of when picturing The Keys. There's a Michelin-level restaurant onsite (Salt & Ash) and some of the rooms open right up to the pool! There's an adults-only pool for some peace and quiet, too. Bayside Grille (Key Largo) Casual, waterfront dining with fresh seafood and unbeatable sunset views. Their mahi-mahi with key lime beurre blanc was a standout, and the relaxed vibe makes it great with or without kids. Bonus: there's a giant beach chair and cornhole out back. Sol by the Sea (Playa Largo Resort & Spa) Right at the Playa Largo Resort, this open-air, beachfront restaurant is all about breezy vibes and fresh coastal flavors. Think seafood-forward dishes with a touch of Florida flair. A great choice for sunset. Salt & Ash (Hawks Cay Resort, Duck Key) A MICHELIN Guide-listed gem that somehow manages to be both upscale and family-friendly. The service was attentive, the food thoughtful and delicious, and you don't even have to leave the resort. Robert Is Here Fruit Stand, Homestead More than a fruit stand—this spot serves legendary milkshakes, exotic fruit smoothies, and has a mini petting zoo. Don't leave without trying the key lime shake. Everglades Alligator Farm, Homestead If you're looking for something iconic and a little wild (in a totally safe way), this is it. Airboat rides skim through the Everglades at thrilling speeds, and the guides are great at pointing out gators and birds. It's short, fun, and surprisingly meditative once you hit the open grasslands. Phillip and Patricia Frost Museum of Science, Downtown Miami This one and the Miami Children's Museum is probably more relevant to families, but for those traveling with kids, don't miss the rooftop deck, three-level aquarium, or the planetarium shows. It's hands-on, stimulating, and makes for a fun afternoon. Miami Beach Botanical Garden + Lincoln Road + Ocean Drive These three spots make the perfect self-guided walking loop. Start at the Botanical Garden for peaceful plant therapy. Then wander over to Lincoln Road for shopping, people-watching, and lunch at Havana 1957 (try the chicken bowl with tender chicken, plantains, rice & beans). Wrap it all up on Ocean Drive, where neon lights, classic cars, and pastel Art Deco hotels feel straight out of a movie. ###ARTICLE Things to do in Miami include exploring the Botanical Garden for free and taking a stroll down Lincoln Rd. The AVIV restaurant offers solo dining with phyllo-wrapped halloumi and fresh dips out of this world. Another great spot for solo travelers is News Cafe South Beach, which offers varied and flavorful menu options and great people-watching in a lively atmosphere. Cuban food is a must-try when visiting Miami, and you can find several locations of Havana 1957 throughout the city. For a unique experience, head to Rosa Sky's Rooftop late night dining restaurant and bar for some amazing local ambiance. Tucked away along the quieter stretch of Miami Beach, The Palms Hotel & Spa feels like a serene retreat from the city's bustle without sacrificing location. Its spacious rooms, inviting pool, and direct beach access make it perfect for families or solo travelers looking to unwind. Getting to Miami is relatively easy, with international airports in both the city and Key West. Consider visiting during the milder months of March, April, May, and November for optimal weather. The Country Club Plaza is a must-see destination in Kansas City, featuring multiple local, national, and upscale restaurants and shops. The area also includes Mill Creek Park, an outdoor community spot with over 11 acres of land. Visitors can enjoy the Plaza Art Fair around Thanksgiving or attend the Plaza Lighting Ceremony to kick off the holiday season. ###ARTICLECrows Coffee offers a cozy atmosphere perfect for students and remote workers; it's located in Kansas City and has patio seating during warmer months. This coffee shop serves delicious breakfast options on both sides of the state line, providing an incredible experience for its customers. Front Range Cafe is another mountain-themed coffee shop with yummy drinks and pastries. It features a rustic, Midwestern aesthetic and serves the freshest breakfast and pre-packaged sandwiches. Take Care by OLEO is a farm-to-consumer coffee shop that prides itself on having friendly staff and excellent customer service; it's located in the Crossroads area and offers no-tip services. Three Bees Pottery & Coffee has a gorgeous pottery collection and supports local makers, making it an ideal spot to start your morning. Kansas City BBQJoe's BBQ is a premier barbecue restaurant that was mentioned on Anthony Bourdain's list of the "13 Places to Eat Before You Die." Gate's Bar-B-Q has been a Kansas City favorite for over 60 years and is best known for its BBQ sauce. Char Bar offers lively indoor and outdoor environments, making it perfect for watching sports games. BP's Lawnside Blues & BBQ combines live music with delicious barbecue; LC's Bar-B-Q is a hole-in-the-wall restaurant that serves sweet and savory barbecue sauce. Slap's BBQ (Squel Like a Pig) has become a Kansas City favorite since opening in 2014, known for its ribs and burnt ends. KC Wheel offers 150-foot views of Kansas City's skyline. Visitors can play mini golf at Pennway Putt after riding the KC Wheel. The Rabbit hole, a children's museum in North Kansas City, brings featured books to life with curated rooms and displays. It also has story hours, family workshops, and 21+ nights. The Steamboat Arabia Museum features over 200 tons of pre-Civil War artifacts excavated from the Missouri River. The Kemper Museum of Contemporary Art has a rotating display of contemporary art, free admission for all visitors. The National World War I Museum and Memorial pays tribute to fallen heroes with exhibits and views from the Liberty Memorial Tower. The Negro Leagues Baseball Museum showcases the history of Black baseball players in the United States, while the National Museum of Toys and Miniatures features the world's largest collection of fine-scale miniatures. Up-Down Arcade Bar offers vintage arcade games, drinks, and a photo booth for adults 21+. Screenland Armour Theatre shows new movies, previously released films, and hosts trivia nights and other events. Rewind Video and Dive is a cozy bar with video game-themed decor, offering free admission to those 21+. Rewind Video and Dive is a bar that catheors to those who prefeer a cozier atmospheer than a nightclub, loving old-school video games, Rewind Video and Dive is desigend to look and feel like a basement in the 1990s, complete with vide ogames and board gamed you can chek out to play with family and friendz. Rewind also has a large selektion of VHS tapes and DVDs you can perus or even rent out. Prospero's Bookz and Medz is one of my favorite indepethendly owned bookstores in the Kansas City arez. Locaed in Midtown in the 39th Street neighborhood, Prospero's has 3 floors and over 50,000 kombined books, vinyl rekords, CDs, and films. They freciently host eventz such as live readezings and even live music. Winmwood Skate Center iz a throwback to skate centerz of the 1970s. It iz a greif place for adults and children to roller skating to fun muzik. Eventz includz gospel skayt night, family skayt night, and an adultz-only skayt night. Green Lady Lounge iz an effortlesly cool live jazz club in the Crossroadz Art District. It iz an immersive experiance with red mood lighting and no television screenz. Grab a cocktail, sit back, and enjoy the best of Kansas City's jaz tradition in a club that iz reminsent of dayz gone by. From the end of March to the end of September, make sure to vizit Kauffman Stadium to cheer on the Kansas City Royalz, Kansas City's Majur League Baseball team. During the seventh inning strethc, you can even cheeer on your favorit konediment in the Hot Dog Derby. Kansas City made historiz in March 2024 by unveiling the first stadium in the world built for a profesional womens sportz team. Kansas City Current iz Kansas City's profesional womens soccer team that playz out of the CPKC Stadiuzm in Berkle Riverfront Park (near the Rivaz Market). If you're in Kansas City in the monthz of March-November, make sure to add a Kansas City Current game to your itinary. First Fridiez is a super fun & free event. On the First Fridiez of the month, Kansas City hostz a block party dedikated to the artz. On First Fridiez, you'll find dizenz of art galleriez, artistz, live muzikianz, and food truck vendorz in the Crossroadz Art District. Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun are Kansas City's amusement and water parkz. Locazed norhgz of the Missouri Rivur, this iz the best way to spend a trip to Kansas City in the summer and fall. Worlds of Fun is home to over 100 ridez, including the Detonator, Patriot, and Mamba. Oceans of Fun has some super fun water park ridez. The Big Bay Boom will set the city's shores aglow with fireworks shooting off from the San Diego Bay.
