Application for CHAS Benefits Households can use this application to apply for the Community Health Assist Scheme (CHAS), which provides subsidies at participating CHAS GP and dental clinics. Required Information To complete this application, you will need: A valid Singpass to login to the e-Service. The names, NRIC / Birth Certificate / FIN numbers, and contact numbers of all household members. Alternatively, you may download a CHAS application form. Should you require assistance, please Call the CHAS hotline at 1800-275-2427 (1800-ASK-CHAS), Monday to Friday from 8.30am to 6.00pm (excluding Public Holidays). All Singapore Citizens are eligible for CHAS. Lower- to middle-income households receive higher healthcare subsidies. Benefits are tiered by household monthly income per person (for households with income), or Annual Value (AV) of home as shown on the NRIC (for households without income). Please note that you and your Family Members will be assessed for eligibility for CHAS based on income and other personal information available in government databases. The information provided in this form may result in an update to your and/or your household members' eligibility for other government healthcare schemes, such as subsidies for MediShield Life Premiums, disability schemes, etc. Beware of phishing! You must have a valid HDB Flat Eligibility (HFE) letter before you may apply for a flat in our sales exercises. The HFE letter will provide you with a holistic understanding of your housing and financing options before you embark on your home buying journey. It will inform you upfront of your eligibility to buy a new or resale flat, as well as the amounts of CPF housing grants and HDB housing loan you are eligible for. Read our frequently asked questions on the HFE letter. You may read our frequently asked questions on sales exercises. After a sales exercise is announced, you can apply for a flat online at the HDB Flat Portal during the application period. An non-refundable administrative fee of \$10 (inclusive of GST) per application is payable by credit card (MasterCard/ Visa) or scanning the QR code using any of the supporting mobile payment apps. At the end of the application period, HDB will place all eligible applications through a computerised ballot to determine the queue order to book the flats. For first-timer families, as their flat allocation quota is at least a specified percentage, they can receive queue numbers bigger than the flat supply set aside for them. HDB will inform all applicants of the outcome of their application. You may check the status of your application when the ballot result is announced. National Service Obligation Under the Enlistment Act 1970, all male Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents, unless exempted, are required to serve National Service (NS). Following the completion of full-time NS, they will become Operationally Ready National Servicemen (NSmen). An NSman's obligation will end at the age of 50 years (for Officers) or 40 years (for other ranks). All male applicants are required to access [www.cmpb.gov.sg](http://www.cmpb.gov.sg) for information on NS before proceeding with this application. All male applicants who are granted Singapore Citizenship (SC) or Singapore Permanent Residence (PR) status as a foreign student or under their parents' sponsorship are liable for NS. They are required to register for NS upon reaching 16 and a half years old, and will be scheduled for enlistment into full-time NS at the earliest opportunity upon reaching 18 years old. MINDEF allows students to attain educational qualifications up to the A Levels certificate, the polytechnic diploma, or an equivalent pre-tertiary qualification before they are required to serve NS. They are enlisted at the earliest opportunity when they have finished pre-tertiary education, or after turning 18, whichever is later. MINDEF does not grant deferment for university studies, regardless of whether such studies have begun. Those who are granted SC or PR in the midst of their university studies will have to disrupt these studies to enlist if they are unable to complete their studies before their enlistment date. Male Singapore citizens who wish to renounce SC may have their renunciation applications withheld by Government if they have not discharged their NS liabilities. Any person who defaults on his NS obligations by committing an offence under the Enlistment Act 1970 shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 years or to both. Renouncing or losing one's SC or PR status without serving or completing full-time NS will have a serious adverse impact on applications to work or study in Singapore, or for any long-term immigration facilities in Singapore, whether now or in the future. Renouncing or losing one's SC or PR status without serving or completing full-time NS will also adversely affect your family members' applications for long-term immigration facilities, their ability to sponsor such facilities, the renewal of their Re-Entry Permits, or their applications for Singapore citizenship or permanent residence.
