Of course, the big news is that the new sound system has arrived! The benefits it brings include: Native WASAPI support on Windows and PipeWire support on Linux. Support for sound input for emulated systems that have microphones or other audio capture hardware. Support for multi-channel input and output. Built-in effects, including a parametric equaliser and dynamic range compressor. Better quality sample rate conversion and mixing, and lower latency. As this is the first release of a major new component, its going to be rough around the edges in some ways. But were already thinking about some of the ways we can improve it further over the coming months. Weve been busy with the sound system, but we havent stopped working on emulation.
