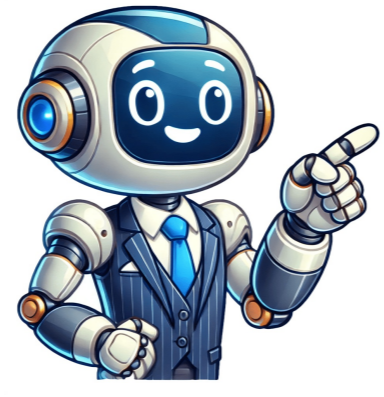


I'm not a bot





John Wayne's indelible mark on American culture has been subject to scrutiny in contemporary times due to his racist and homophobic views. Collaborating with top filmmakers like John Ford, Don Siegel, and Howard Hawks, Wayne's iconic western hero persona was rarely seen meeting his demise on screen. However, he met his end in a few notable films: the 1942 movie *Reap the Wild Wind* by Cecil B. DeMille, where an octopus attack claimed him; *The Man Who Shot Liberty Valance* (1962) by John Ford, depicting natural causes as his death; and *The Shootist* (1976), where he died from a gunshot wound as a retired gunslinger facing mortality. Interestingly, some of his most iconic roles involved his characters being killed off, including Sgt John M Stryker in *Sands of Iwo Jima* and Davy Crockett in *The Alamo*.
